

CHANGE TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

MILWAUKEE BAY OFFSHORE SERIES

As of June 08, 2024, the Sailing Instructions (Sis) for the Milwaukee Bay Offshore Series (MBOS) shall be changed as follows:

3. COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

- 3.4 A boat shall not monitor private communications between race committee personnel, except as permitted by the notice of race or the sailing instructions.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 5.1 The scheduled dates of events and races with the number of races to be sailed and the time of the first warning are shown in the table below.

- 5.2 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.
- 5.3 The first race warning signal for daytime races shall be made no later than 1400 hrs.
- 5.4 On days when 2 or more races are scheduled, the warning signal for the last race will be made no later than 1500 hrs.
